- 4. The progress of five incubatees was discussed and monitored. The incubatees were suggested to contact their mentors frequently and provide the progress well in time. The detailed comments/suggestions are appended below:
 - Anuj Sharma: The prototype in ready with website localguy.in. The incubatee is suggested to look
 for the marketing strategies to meet the profit and capture the market. The business model needs to be
 more focused. (MENTORING and sustenance allowance-continued)
- Uday Bhanu: The candidate is working on the prototype. The business model needs to be more focused. (MENTORING and sustenance allowance-continued)
- O Anil Singla: The incubatee himself didn't attend the meeting second time in the row. The representative was not able to state the progress of the project after March onwards. There was no clarity in the development stage of the product. The incubator cell did not see any role in the incubation of the idea in our center as the candidate has its own business analyst and well versed experts. It seems that the applicant needs to avail this incubator facility to get connected with HP Govt. There was no survey data, how the product will be useful for the residents of HP (proposal needs to be relooked and verified through personal visit to working place of Incubatee)
- Yatin Machan and team: Incubatee has been advised to contact his mentor on regular basis for
 further improvement in their project. The candidate has assembled device with tools procured from
 other companies he is not in contact with his mentors on regular basis. The devices need to be verified
 and validated by the Mentor. The product needs to be improved in terms of internet connectivity in the
 remote regions. The business models needs to be clarified. (MENTORING-continued,
 recommended for Sustenance allowance from April 1, 2018 onwards)
- Saras Gupta: The candidate is working on the prototype development. The shoes are ready however,
 the candidate is planning to fit the prototype into the shoe sole. The weight increase in the shoe needs
 to be looked after and the sensitivity of the shoe sensors to detect the hindrance needs to be more
 focussed. (MENTORING-continued, Sustenance allowance from 1 April, 2018)
- Sairas Negi: The prototype is ready with improved device. The candidate needs assistance in patenting. He has been advised to contact Dr. Aparna Sharma (aparnasarin@yahoo.com) or Ms. Ritika Kanwar (ritikaknawar15@ymail.com) of Himachal Patent Information Centre (HPPIC) Shimla for patent filing of his design/prototype. - 5. The proposals from six new applicants were discussed and recommendations were made. Out of six, two were recommended for sustenance allowance and mentoring from May 1,2018 onwards and the two were advised to resubmit the project proposal. One proposal was not recommended and one proposal was recommended to contact DIC Solan. The details are below:
 - Ankit Kashiv: The project is an idea stage as the candidate is looking for starting up a resort based on green energy concept, however, more R&D needs to be done in this regard. The project may be feasible in future and the candidate is recommended to resubmit the project with clear aims and objective. The project is simply focussed to start Resort near Kausali, for which candidate is already having land. Committee has advised the candidate to apply under different scheme available through District Industries Centre, Solan H P. As per candidate's information the same project is planned to be submitted under STANDUP India for women empowerment. (Refer to District Industries Centre, Solan H P. For financial assistance)
 - O Ankush Bansal: The candidate is advised to go for survey on the requirements of the farmers. The project needs to be resubmitted with proper field survey which could show that wheter there is demand of the proposed web application or not. As this kind of information is already provided from other agencies and the innovation needs to be addressed in the resubmitted proposal. (RESUBMIT)
 - Raja Gaurav: The candidate has experience on the field of water resource and aims to establish in the field of Rain water harvesting. They are working as consultant in the rainwater harvesting systems. They are focused to promoting water conservation. The idea is good from the point of view of sustainable development and also it is demand of present scenario particularly in the place very water is in scarcity. Some innovation has been put in the water purification system and on other parts also which needs to be verify and updated if required. The business models needs to be more elaborated and there is need to workout on this aspect. (MENTORING- Sustenance allowance may be provided from May 1, 2018)
 - Supriya: The idea is innovative and in the phase of prototype development. The candidate needs to work on the availability and feasibility to procure products from different regions of the state. The candidate is running a firm with 10-12 people working there. The candidate needs to propose firm business plan. (MENTORING- Sustenance allowance may be provided)
 - Ohruv Mohan Kapil: The scope and feasibility of the idea needs to be reinvestigated and reviewed. The applicant is advised to refine the roadmap of the project. There was no business model plan. The applicant is advised to resubmit the proposal. (RESUBMIT)
 - Vishal Sharma: The project seems to be unrealistic to the needs of the residents of Himachal. The incubatee is working on the same business plan in Australia and proposing the same for the city Like Solan. It is more or like extension of business plan in India and committee feels that there is no need of mentoring in this case. The candidate can apply in any other scheme available through District Industries Centre, Solan H P. A proper feasibility survey report has not been worked out and prepared. The candidate needs to overlook on his idea in context with Himachal. (NOT RECOMMENDED)
- One candidate Mr Neeraj also attended the meeting and presented his idea. However, he has not submitted his proposal till date. He has been advised to submit the proposal so that it can be evaluated by the committee.
