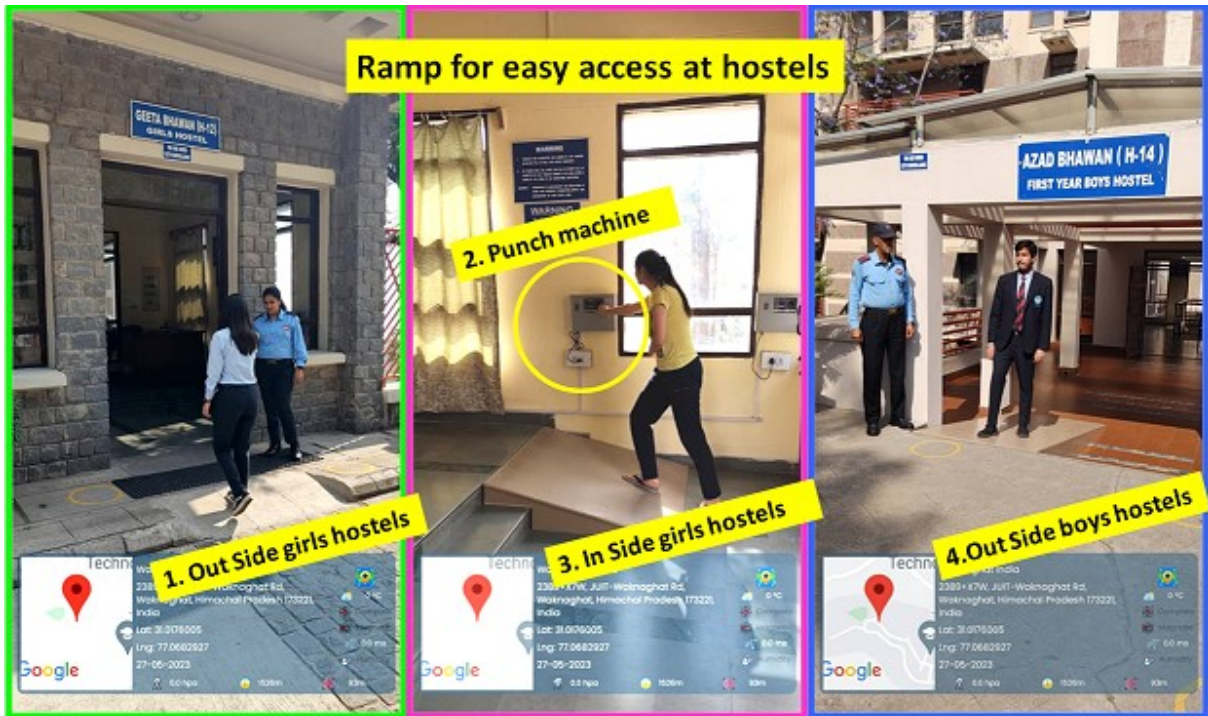
1. Built environment with ramps/lifts for easy access to classrooms

University buildings have provision of lift for barrier free access for students, staff, visitors and differently abled people. Lift of the University is located in the main academic block. Ramp-Rails, an inclined plane, are built in addition to staircases near E Block and C Block (Faculty residential area). The ramps are carefully designed as per specifications to be used by the differently abled and senior citizen people.



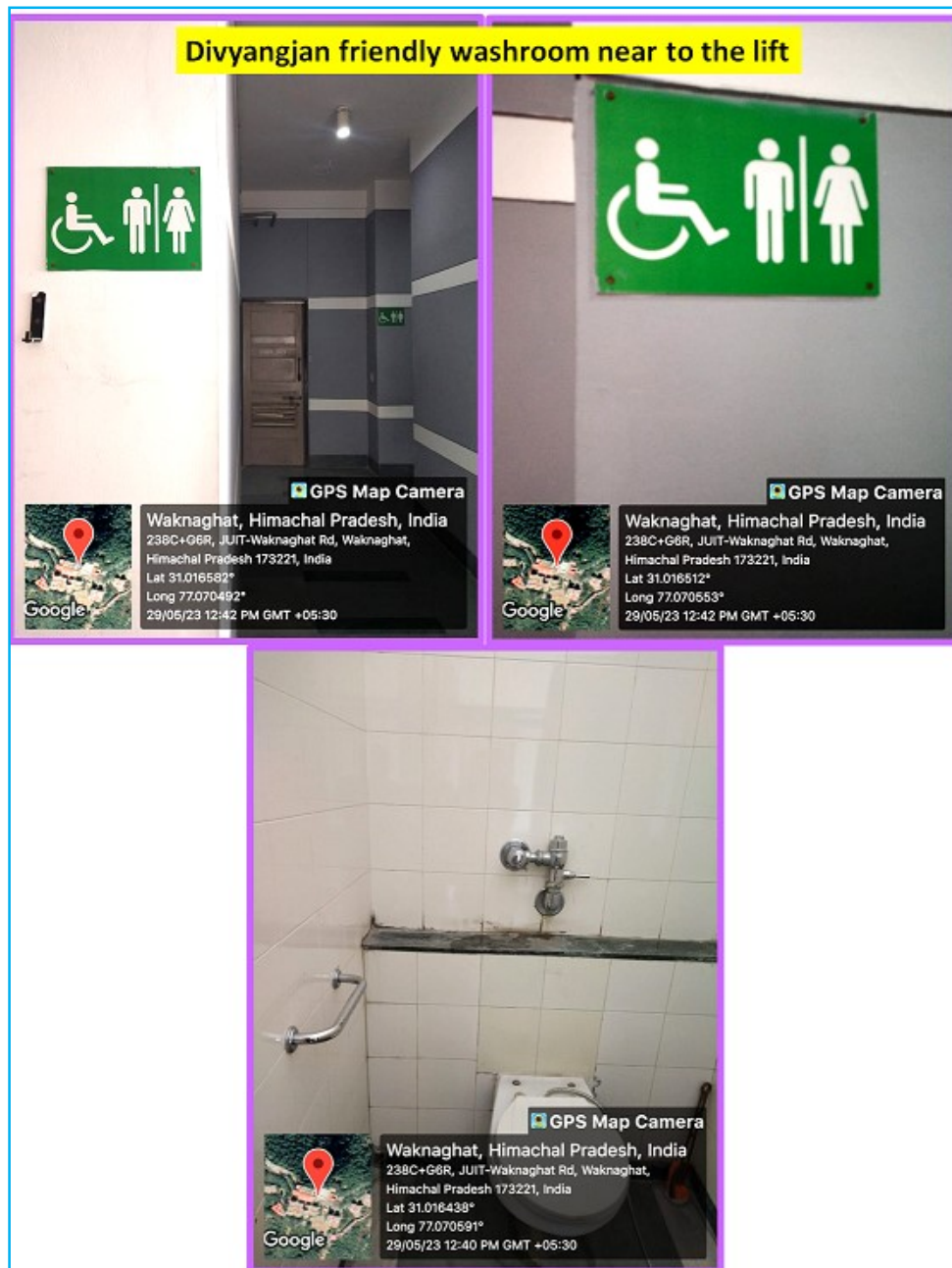
Ramp for easy access to the Dispensary





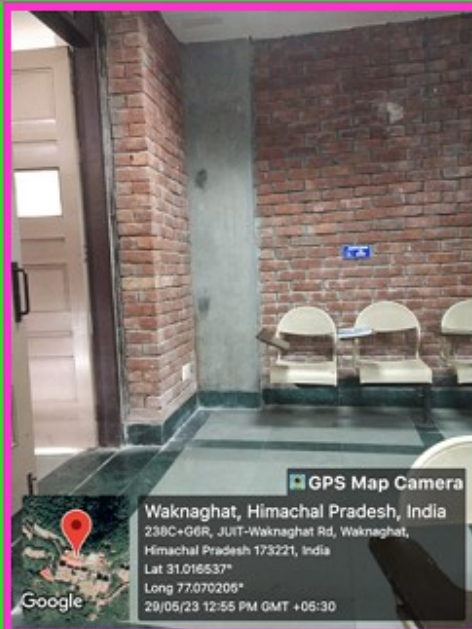
2. Divyangjan friendly washrooms

The disabled washrooms are well equipped with fixtures and facilities for the disabled to use comfortably and conveniently. 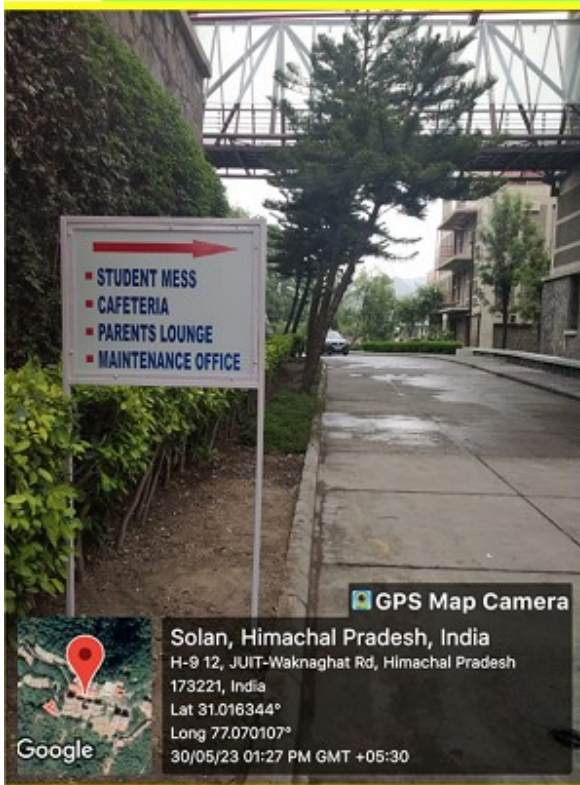
Seating arrangements for divyangjan in classrooms near entry



Reserved parking lots for divyangjan in the campus



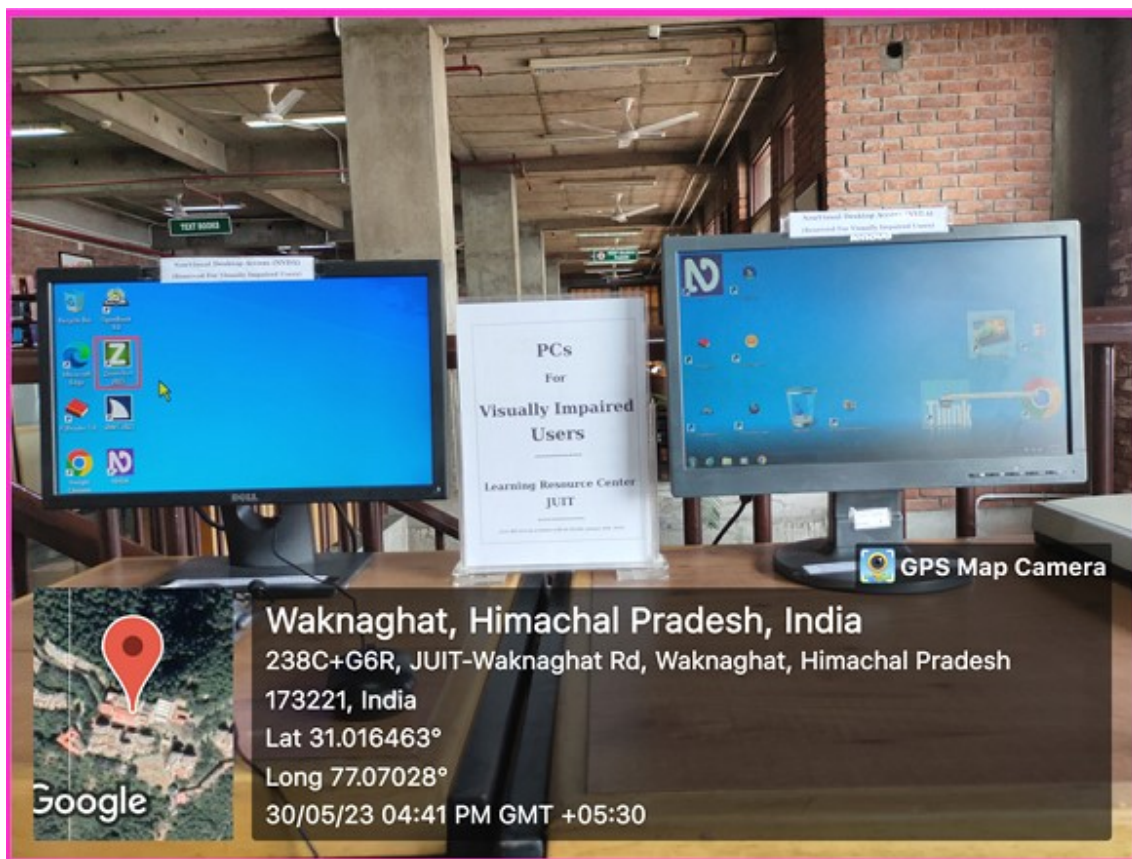

4. Assistive technology and facilities for Divyangjan

Screen reading software

University LRC established new facility for visually impaired students who are unable and still desirous to read and improve their knowledge. The facility was set up with the aim to empower and encourage visually-challenged students to pursue education or research. LRC has reserved 3 PCs (three systems) installed Non Visual Desktop Access (NVDA) to help such students who suffered because of low vision. With the help of 'screen reading software' and support of audio facility, they can read the e-books with screen reading software. As we don't have any visually impaired student, faculty or staff the photo was taken without any person.

5. Provision for enquiry and information : Human assistance, reader, scribe, soft copies of reading material, screen reading

- University has a well defined reception desk which provides all information as human assistance to divyangjan.
