Policy for Promotion of Research 2022

1. PURPOSE

The objective of research policy at JUIT is to inculcate a culture of innovation in research amongst its faculty, students and staff.

2. OBJECTIVES

- To develop an environment for research and innovation
- To support the faculty and scholars in carrying out their research activities
- To encourage Peer-reviewed publications in reputed/indexed journals
- Encouraging faculty to get sponsored research projects
- To promote interdisciplinary and multi-disciplinary national and international collaborations.
- To develop Centers of Excellence in novel research areas.
- To encourage researchers to file patents for their innovations in research
- To create an ecosystem for developing entrepreneurship

3. CUSTODIAN OF POLICY

All research related activities and policy in JUIT are governed through the Office of Dean Academic & Research (A&R). The office of Dean (A&R) functions under the Vice Chancellor - JUIT.

4. INITIATIVES FOR PROMOTION OF RESEARCH IN JUIT

JUIT implements the following initiatives to meet and accomplish the research objectives.

For Faculty

Research Emphasis during Faculty Recruitment in JUIT: During faculty recruitments at JUIT, impetus is given on selection of Doctorate and Post-Doctorate Faculties from institutes of repute. Peer-reviewed publications and their ability to submit innovative & collaborative projects remains on focus during selection process. To enhance research and innovation in universities, Jaypee Education System has Director of innovation, Research and Development (DIRD) to identify and fund novel

- projects\centers of excellence involving faculty and students.
- New faculty is provided with a competitive seed money grant of Rs. 1.00
 Lacs to start their research activity.
- Support for Academic\ Research events: Administration and financial support is provided to faculty\staff for attending conferences, workshops, seminars, Faculty Development Programs. Support is also provided for attending academic\ research events in India as well as abroad. Duty leave\ sabbatical leave is provided as applicable to attend these events.
- Performance Linked Annual Appraisals: JUIT is having performance linked annual appraisals with substantial weightage for research performance of faculty including their involvement in research projects and quality research publications.
- Special and Book/periodicals allowance: All Faculty members are given Special Allowance on monthly basis (Rs 21,000 for Professors, Rs 17,000 for Associate Professors, and Rs 13,600 for Assistant Professors). Apart from this; Book and Periodicals' allowance of Rs 4000, Rs 3500, Rs 2500 is provided on monthly basis to Professors, Associate Professors, and Assistant Professors, respectively.
- IPR Cell: Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Cell of JUIT is TIFAC, DST sponsored working in collaboration with HP Patent Information Centre (Govt. of HP), Shimla. IPR Cell offers IPR education; ensures identification, protection, and filing of innovations arising out of research work carried out in the University.
- Travel Support: University vehicle/TA/DA as applicable is provided to the faculty/staff/students for participating in academic and research visits in and out of state. Selected faculty members also get full/partial financial support for overseas travel to participate in such events.
- Imprest Facility: With the approval of Vice Chancellor, imprest facility is available for academic/research activities. In case of delay of research grants, respective Project investigators may get advance/loan basis for their project activities.
- Consultancy: University encourages the faculty to involve in consultancy work with public as well as private sector.

For Research Students

- Teaching Assistantship: University provides Teaching Assistantship to Ph.D. students for 3 years where each candidate is paid Rs. 22,000/- per month. GATE as well as Non-Gate qualified students (on performance basis) are eligible to receive Rs 12,000/- per month fellowship. GAT-B qualified M.Sc. Biotechnology students receive Rs. 5000 per month.
- Contingency Funds: Selected Research students are given contingency funds for attending conferences/characterization and other research related work by the University and from TIED cell (Chief Minister Incubation Centre) of JUIT.
- Support for Attending academic/research events: Financial support to students is given for attending national Conferences/Workshop and related events. University vehicle is also provided with the permission of concerned authorities.
- IP Support: IPR Cell of JUIT supports the students for filing their patents.
 IPR students' body along with faculty coordinators sensitize students of all streams regarding IP procedures and its importance.
