

Report of Webinar “Women Safety”



The Internal Complaints Committee, JUIT Wagnaghat organized a webinar on the topic '**Women Safety**' on 24th June 2021 from 11.00 am to 12.00 pm on the Google Meet platform. The event was attended by over 95 participants including faculty, research scholars, and students from different universities across India. Dr. Hemant Sood, the faculty member of ICC, commenced the webinar by extending her warm welcome to the speaker of the session **Dr. Deepa Rathore** (Clinical Psychologist DDU ZH, Ripon, Shimla), Honorable Director Prof. Samir Dev Gupta, Dean of Academic, JUIT, faculties, and participants of the event.

Dr. Deepa Rathore who has been working as a clinical psychologist in DDUZH, Shimla since October 2013 is an alumnus of St. Luke, Solan, holds a Post Graduate Diploma in Clinical Psychology and a Doctorate in Psychology from HPU. She also has a one-year of counseling experience as a school psychologist in KVS Chandigarh.

She initiated the discourse by emphasizing how physical and emotional abuse of women has been a major human rights issue for several years amongst all socio-economic groups. She highlighted that with the outbreak of Covid-19 there have been unprecedented obstacles for women such that an increase of 21% in domestic violence was reported. While discussing about the problems relating to working women she encouraged the audience to contribute towards women empowerment for the welfare of the community. Dr. Deepa also stated her faith on the

next generation who will resist the inequalities we observe every day and internalize these ideals in our work.

Violence against Women

- Over the years, whether it was the Rameeza Bee rape case(1978), Manorama in Manipur(2004), the Nirbhaya case in Delhi(2012) or now in Hathras, these sexual offenses against women exposed the reality of structural violence.
- It must be noted that in India, there are a range of intersections like identity, social structures and customs and traditions that lead to such systematic violence.


